Learned counsel appearing for the petitioner would make a statement that in the light of the decision taken by the Improvement Trust, Patiala in the proceedings held on 12.12.2014 as per Resolution No.3027 dated 12.12.2014 and whereby allottees of Plot Nos.577, 578 and 593 of Shaheed Sewa Singh Thikriwala Nagar Scheme have been granted one year time to shift the commercial activities being run in such plots to an alternative place, there has been substantial compliance of the order dated 6.5.2014, passed by this Court in CWP No.8456 of 2008.

The contempt petition, accordingly, is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.
