This contempt petition has been filed asserting willful disobedience of the order dated 28.2.2014, passed by this Court while disposing of CRM No. M-20696 of 2013.

Suffice it to notice that the petition had been disposed of with a direction to the S.S.P., Gurdaspur to expedite the matter and to furnish cancellation report in regard to F.I.R. No.100 dated 28.5.2013 under sections 363, 366, 506, 120-B I.P.C, Police Station City, Gurdaspur.

In the reply filed on behalf of the State, it has been submitted that the cancellation report was presented before the C.J.M on 28.5.2014 and thereafter the matter was posted for 25.7.2014 for recording statement of the complainant. It so transpires that on 20.11.2014 the cancellation report has been returned by observing that the police officials have failed to procure the presence of the complainant.

Learned State counsel furnishes an assurance to the Court that the cancellation report would now be submitted and even the complainant would be produced before the Illaqa Magistrate concerned, within a period

of four weeks from today.

In view of the facts noticed herein above, this Court is satisfied that no case for contempt is made out.

Contempt petition is, accordingly, dismissed.

Rule discharged.
