This order shall dispose of COCP Nos.2753 and 2754 of 2014.

Even on second call, counsel appearing for the petitioner(s) has not come present.

The instant contempt petition arises out of judgment dated 27.05.2014 passed by the Division Bench of this Court in LPA No.1231 of 2012 as also LPA No.1255 of 2012 in terms of which the respondent/State had been directed to offer appointment to the present petitioners against the post of Driver from the date when others were appointed. Insofar as the pay was concerned, the benefits were granted only on notional basis.

Learned State counsel has filed in Court today, a compliance report by way of affidavit dated 15.01.2015 of the Director General, State Transport, Haryana along with Annexure R-1. The same is taken on record.

Perusal of the status report would reveal that vide memo dated 31.10.2014 (Annexure R-1), the petitioners were issued order for joining as Heavy Vehicle Drivers. As part of Annexure R-1, is also an order bearing

No.1838 dated 05.11.2014 and a reading thereof would reveal that consequent upon acceptance of the terms and conditions of offer of appointment, the petitioners have already submitted their joining report. Furthermore, the petitioners have been granted the regular pay scale of Heavy Vehicle Driver notionally w.e.f. 26.06.2008 i.e. the date when other persons have been made to join on the post in question.

In view of the compliance report, this Court satisfied that there has been complete compliance of the directions issued by this Court.

Accordingly, the contempt petitions are disposed of as having been rendered infructuous.

Rule discharged.
