Counsel for the petitioner, after arguing for sometime, prays that liberty may be granted to the petitioner to challenge the action of the respondents, offering him appointment to the post of Clerk vide order dated 05.06.2015 (Annexure R-1) as the same is not in consonance with the instructions as were prevalent at the time when the writ petition of the petitioner i.e. Civil Writ Petition No.13433 of 2004 (Parveen Kumar Vs. State of Haryana and others) was allowed vide order dated 05.02.2008 (Annexure P-1), which order has been upheld by the Division Bench of this Court as also by the Hon'ble Supreme Court.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed

of with liberty as prayed for. It is made clear that if the petitioner joins in pursuance of the order dated 05.06.2015 (Annexure R-1) within a period of one week from today, he be allowed to join ofcourse subject to fulfillment of the conditions. His claim will not be rejected only on the ground that he did not report for duty within the time stipulated in the order dated 05.06.2015 (Annexure R-1).

Rule discharged.
