Learned counsel for the petitioner has admitted that he has withdrawn the amount of ₹4,33,000/- deposited by respondent No.1 which has been paid by them without prejudice to their right which is under challenge in the S.L.P before the Supreme Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since the payment has been made to him after a delay of about one year, the respondents are also liable to pay the simple interest @ 12% p.a, which the respondents have denied. It is, however, submitted by the learned counsel for the respondents that if a representation is made by the petitioner in this regard, the same shall be decided in accordance with law.

Accordingly, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to make a representation to the respondents with regard to the amount of interest which has been paid late to him and if a representation is made within a period of one month from today, the same shall be decided by the respondents within a period of two months thereafter.
