Reply by way of short affidavit of Balbir Singh, Director of Public Instructions (Secondary Education) Punjab has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

The petitioners alleges the violation of the orders passed in CWP no.1623 of 2013 which are extracted herebelow:-

“Directions are issued to the respondents to issue a public notice calling for applications from interested candidates possessing higher qualifications B.P.E/B.P.Ed/D.P.Ed/ N.P.Ed. Prior to 29.4.2008 within a period of 30 days from the date of such publication of the notice. The process of counselling which has been initiated in pursuance to the public notice dated 18.1.2013 shall stand

deferred till the insurance of the public notice till expiry of the last

date of receipt of the applications in pursuance to the said notice.

Thereafter the respondents shall proceed to finalize the selection as per the criteria which was advertised on 13.4.2008.”

It is averred in para 4 that public notice was issued on 4.3.2014 inviting applications from eligible candidates and the merit list has been revised pursuant to the process adopted in terms of the orders of the writ Court. It has further been averred in para 6 that the petitioner did not make the grade. Merit of the petitioners and the last selected has also been depicted in this para.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, I am of the view that since the orders of the writ Court have been complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, leaving the petitioners to their remedies in law.
