**Augustine George Masih, J. (Oral)**

Counsel for respondent No.2, on the basis of communication dated 10.03.2015 states that the ex-gratia amount of Rs.5,00,000/- has already been sanctioned and a cheque dated 10.03.2015 in the name of the petitioner drawn on State Bank of India, Arunachal Pradesh has been issued which has been dispatched to the petitioner.

Photocopy of the same has been handed over to the counsel for the petitioner. He further states that the said cheque will be delivered to the petitioner within a period of one week.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for respondent No.2, the present contempt petition has become infructuous.

Disposed of, as such.

Rule discharged.

Liberty is however, granted to the petitioner to revive the contempt petition in case the statement made by the counsel for respondent No.2 is not honoured by the said respondent.
