The present petition was admitted on 20.01.2015 alongwith CP No.150 of 2006. As none appeared on behalf of the petitioner company, a common citation of admission of both the aforesaid petitions was directed to be published in the two newspapers namely 'Indian Express' (English) & 'Jansatta' (Hindi) both Haryana editions and in the Official Gazette of Government of Haryana.

Today, again no one appeared on behalf of the petitioner-company and also not filed any affidavit of publication as directed by this Court on 20.01.2015.

It seems that petitioner is not interested in pursuing the matter and, therefore, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution with a liberty to the petitioner for revival of the petition to comply the aforesaid order dated 20.01.2015 with prior permission of this Court.

Liberty is granted to the petitioner for revival of the petition in other connected matters i.e. CP No.327 of 2002, 254 of 2003, 48 of 2004, 49 of 2004 and 118 of 2004 which were disposed of on 20.01.2015, in case the present petition comes out of liquidation.

Let a copy of this order be given to learned counsel for the petitioner as well to the petitioner-company for revival of these petition.
