**AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASI, J. (ORAL)**

Counsel for the respondent, on the basis of the order dated 25.11.2014 passed by the Additional Chief Secretary and Financial commissioner to Government of Haryana, Revenue and Disaster Department, states that the orders passed by this Court have been duly complied with. This renders the present contempt petition infructuous.

Counsel for the petitioner has referred to the order dated 25.11.2014 (Annexure R/1) to contend that the claim of the petitioner has been referred to the Chief Secretary, Government of Haryana for exemption from passing the type test and, therefore, a direction may

be issued to the Chief Secretary, Government of Haryana, to take an appropriate decision thereon within some specified time.

In view of the above, a direction is issued to the Chief Secretary, Government of Haryana, to take a final decision on the reference made by the Additional Chief Secretary and Financial Commissioner to Government of Haryana, Revenue and Disaster Department dated 25.11.2014 (Annexure R/1) expeditiously and preferably within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. Decision so taken be conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.
