MAHESH GROVER, J.

It is not disputed that the pension in terms of the order of the writ Court has been released to the petitioner, however, learned counsel for the petitioner raises dispute regarding revised pensionary benefits having not been paid.

This fact is controverted by the learned counsel for the respondents who has stated that all benefits have been paid to the petitioner.

Petitioner has not filed any counter affidavit to controvert the aforesaid fact.

Hence, instant petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to make a representation to the respondents pointing out shortfalls in the amount and the same shall be considered by the respondents as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of two months from the date of making such a representation.
