Compliance report by way of affidavit of Gurmeet Singh Chauhan, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

The order dated 31.7.2015, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala to consider and decide the representation (attached as Annexure P-1 with the writ petition) within a period of 2 months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and an enquiry has been conducted whereupon a speaking order has also been passed on the representation of the petitioner.

In view of above, when orders of the writ Court stands complied with, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, leaving the petitioner to his remedies in law. Rule against the respondents is discharged.
