Learned State counsel has filed in Court today a compliance report by way of affidavit dated 29.01.2015 of the Director, State Council for Educational Research and Training, Punjab. Copy has been furnished to the counsel for the petitioner.

Appended along with the compliance report is a speaking order dated 25.01.2015 at Annexure R-1 in terms of which the judgment dated 07.07.2014 passed by this Court in CWP No.6134 of 2014 has been complied with and the petitioner has been treated as a qualified candidate in the BC category by granting her 83 marks out of 150 marks.
