Counsel for the parties agree that the orders, as passed by this Court, stand complied with except for the payment of arrears of revised pay scale.

Counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Sh. Gurmeet Pal Singh, Senior Assistant, o/o DEO(S) Bathinda, states that the bills have been duly submitted to the Sub-Treasury Officer, Rampura Phul, District Bathinda, which are likely to be cleared at an early date. He further states that the payment would be released to the petitioners thereafter.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the respondents, the present contempt petition is disposed of with

directions to the Sub-Treasury Officer, Rampura Phul, District Bathinda, to release the amount, as per the bills submitted by the District Education Officer, Bathinda, within a period of five weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioners to revive the present contempt petition, in case the payment is not released to the petitioners within the time stipulated above.
