AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for respondent No. 3 states that the orders passed by this Court stand complied with qua Sh. Pardeep Kumar, who was petitioner No. 1 in CWP No. 20315 of 2009 as he had submitted a representation in compliance with the order dated 20.04.2010 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court. Counsel further states that in case the petitioners move an appropriate application/representation to the respondents, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously and a speaking order passed.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for respondent No. 3, I am of the considered view that the orders passed by this Court have been duly complied with.

In case the petitioners move an appropriate application/representation to the respondents within a period of three weeks' from today, the same shall be considered and decided by the Chief Executive Officer, Zila Parishad, Sangrur-respondent No. 3 within a period of two months from the date of receipt of such representation.
