Counsel for respondent No. 3 states that no representation has been submitted by the petitioners as per the order passed by this Court and, therefore, the matter could not be further proceeded with for complying with the order dated 24.05.2010 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No. 9619 of 2010. Counsel further states that in case the petitioners move an appropriate application/representation to the respondents, the same shall be considered and decided expeditiously and a speaking order passed.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for respondent No. 3, I am of the considered view that the orders passed

by this Court have been duly complied with.

In case the petitioners move an appropriate application/representation to the respondents within a period of three weeks' from today, the same shall be considered and decided by the Chief Executive Officer, Zila Parishad, Sangrur-respondent No. 3 within a period of two months from the date of receipt of such representation.
