Counsel for the respondents, with reference to para-5 of the affidavit dated 27.11.2014 (Annexure R/2) filed by the Director General of Police, Punjab-respondent No. 2, states that the name of petitioner No 2 has been approved for consideration for enlistment as special case subject to verification of physical efficiency test, medical fitness and character verification. Qua petitioner No. 1, it has been stated that there are two criminal cases pending against him, which relate to his indulgence in the sale of illicit liquor and he was arrested in both the cases. He has, thus, not been found fit for employment in the Police Department and accordingly, his claim has been filed.

Counsel for the respondents, on instructions from

Sh. Vijay Kumar, Senior Assistant, DGP Office, Punjab, states that

the orders passed by this Court have been complied with and the specific orders passed qua the claim of the petitioners will be served upon them within a period of two weeks from today.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for the respondents, the present petition is disposed of as infructuous.

It is, however, left open to the petitioners, if not satisfied with the orders which will be supplied to them, to avail of the remedy in accordance with law.

In case, the orders in the case of the petitioners passed by the competent authority in compliance of the order passed by this Court are not supplied to them, as has been stated by the counsel for the respondents, within the time so mentioned, it would be open to the petitioners to revive the present contempt petition.
