AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the respondents, on the basis of the reply which has been filed, submits that the arrears as per entitlement of the petitioner have been paid to him. He states that the petitioner is further claiming the benefit of the difference in pay-scale because of the notional promotion which has been granted to him. The said claim is not maintainable and therefore, a speaking order dated 18.02.2014 has already been passed in this regard, copy of which is appended as Annexure P-2.

A perusal of the order dated 03.12.2013 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court only indicates that the legal notice had to be decided and if something was found due to the petitioner, the same was to be released. The respondents have passed the speaking order dated 18.02.2014 (Annexure P-2) wherein the claim with regard to the petitioner which he is asserting in the present contempt petition is still remaining, cannot be gone into. He may, therefore, avail of his remedy, in accordance with law, in case, he is aggrieved by the order dated 18.02.2014 (Annexure P-2).

Disposed of as infructuous.
