30.10.2014, stands deposited on 16.01.2015 vide receipt No. 328.

Status report, as filed in Court, is taken on record.
According to the said status report, the petitioner has been issued
the appointment letter on 02.04.2015 (Annexure R-1).

Counsel for the petitioner states that vide order dated
22.05.2014 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in CWP No. 10225
of 2010, directions were issued to the respondents to issue the
appointment letters within a period of two months from the date of
receipt of certified copy of the order. The certified copy was supplied
but still the appointment letter was not issued and the same has now
been issued in April, 2015. For the said period, the petitioner has

lost the benefits, which include salary and other benefits.

If that be so, the petitioner may avail of her remedy in accordance with law.

Disposed of with above observations.
