The order dated 17.1.2012, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to consider the petitioner for appointment in terms of the merit position and pass appropriate orders informing her of the appointment and place of positing.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed whereby claim of the petitioner for appointment has been rejected on the ground of being lower in merit.

In view of above, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order so passed in case she is dis-satisfied with the same.
