Compliance report has been filed in Court today, copy has already been supplied to the counsel for the petitioner. Counsel for the petitioner states that the pension and arrears w.e.f. 01.06.2014 to 30.04.2015 amounting to ₹ 81,590/- has been received by the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner states that he is, as of now, not in a position to state that as to whether the pension for the months of May and June has been released to the petitioner or not.

In case the pension payable to the petitioner has not been released for the months of May and June, the same be released within a period of two weeks from today. It is further directed that the pension to the petitioner shall be paid regularly by 7th of each month till the finalization of the dispute between the parties or any order in favour of the respondents is

passed by the Competent Court.

Liberty is however, granted to the petitioner for revival of the contempt petition, in case the directions are not complied with or violated by the respondents.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of accordingly.
