AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the petitioner states that although as per the reply which has been filed by the respondent, payments have been made to the petitioner but the details and the break-up thereof has not been specified therein. He further states that the petitioner would only be in a position to comment about the payments received if the details are known to her.

Counsel for the respondent undertakes, on instructions from Shri Jai Singh, Deputy Superintendent and Shri Ram Kumar, Account Officer, O/o DGHE, Haryana, that the details and the break-up of the payments made to the petitioner shall be supplied to her within a period of two weeks from today. In case, petitioner still feels that some other benefits have to be released to the petitioner in terms of the orders passed by this Court, representation to that effect may be filed by her to the Principal of the Government College for

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Women, Rohtak, who shall, on receipt of the same, consider the same and pass appropriate orders within a period of 30 days of such submission of the representation.

In case, the claim is accepted, the consequential benefits be released to her within a further period of one month.
