Narnaul-respondent is present in Court.

Learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, states that at the time when the notices were issued, prior to receipt of the same, he was transferred from Gurgaon to Narnaul and the office failed to intimate him. He, however, states that the order passed by this Court stands duly complied with and all the petitioners have been released the amount due. This, he states, on the basis of the bank statements appended along with the reply (Annexure R-3).
