It is the contention of the counsel for the petitioners that the order passed by this Court has not been fully complied with as only six petitioners out of nine have been granted the benefit of promotion. He states that the posts were available, against which they should have been promoted from a prior date and all petitioners in any case were entitled to promotion, which qua three the benefit has not be considered properly. He prays for liberty to avail of the remedy in accordance with law against the action taken by the respondents.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.
