Counsel for the respondent, on the basis of status report, submits that the order passed by this Court dated 05.09.2014 (Annexure P-1) stands complied with, as the representation of the petitioner has been duly considered and decided. F.I.R. No.39 dated 18.05.2014 under Sections 452/323/34 IPC was registered against Gurkirat Singh, Jaspal Singh, Sukhpal Singh and Shinder Kaur. Section 325 IPC was added as one of the seven injuries received by Balwinder Singh was found to be grievous. Challan has also been presented in the Court.

In view of the statement made by counsel for the respondent, the present contempt is disposed of as infructuous.
