By order dated 22.11.2013, the Division Bench passed the declaratory order that the land described as *Shamilat Patti* in the jamabandi would not vest in the Gram Panchayat and would vest in the Gram Panchayat as *Shamilat Zail*.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioners that the order passed by this Court has been upheld by the Supreme Court and thereafter they had served a notice to the Gram Panchayat for passing a resolution to undo the earlier resolution passed by which the land in possession of the petitioners have been shown to have been vested in the Gram Panchayat.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioners, I am of the considered opinion that the remedy does not lie with the petitioners by filing the present petition because there is no direction issued by this Court which has been violated by the respondents. However, the petitioners have other remedies which they may avail, in accordance with law.
