Counsel for the respondents states that the cost, as imposed by this Court, has been deposited today. He further states that a speaking order dated 24.06.2014 (Annexure R-1) stands passed, according to which, an amount of ₹ 22,27,946/- is still to be released to the petitioner, which could not be done because of the non-availability of the sufficient amount. He states that with the release of new budget, the payment due to the petitioner will be credited to its account within a period of six weeks from today. He makes this statement on instructions from Sh. Jiwan Lal Garg, Executive Engineer.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to revive the same, in case the statement made by the counsel for the respondents is not adhered to.
