An additional affidavit has been filed by respondent No. 3, according to which, the order passed by this Court has been duly complied with and a speaking order dated 30.06.2014 (Annexure R-2) is attached herewith.

The stand taken by the respondents in the said order as regards the eligibility of the Junior Engineers is in accordance with the Statutory Rules and in compliance with the order passed by this Court in LPA No. 1150 of 2012. It is, however, clarified that the petitioners will be entitled to the benefit of arrears as a consequence of the order passed by this Court from the date they completed 15 years of service from the initial date of their appointment, subject to eligibility and that they have not been

promoted to the next higher post. The arrears be calculated and released to the petitioners within a period of six weeks from today.

The contempt petition is disposed of with above observations.
