Cost, as imposed by this Court stands deposited on 24.03.2015. Short reply by way of affidavit of the Director Public Instructions (Secondary Education), Punjab-respondent No. 2, filed in Court, taken on record.

Counsel for the respondents, on the basis of the reply which has been filed, states that the claim of the petitioner for promotion under the handicapped category has been duly considered but as of now, he has not been found eligible for the said benefit because of he being lower in seniority. It has further been stated in the order dated 28.11.2014 (Annexure R-1/T) passed by the Special Secretary, Punjab Government Rural Development and Panchayat

Department that as and when the petitioner is found to be eligible as per his seniority, his case for promotion would be appropriately considered and if found entitled to, the benefit would be granted.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as such.

Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to avail of the remedy, in accordance with law, against the order dated 28.11.2014 (Annexure R-1/T)
