Cost, as imposed by this Court stands deposited on
10.04.2015. Affidavit is taken on record.

As per the said affidavit, the claim of the petitioner has
been duly considered and appropriate relief granted to them.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the order was
passed by this Court with an intention to give benefit to the petitioner
so that they could admit the students for the present session and
because of the delay on the part of the respondents, they have lost
the said opportunity. He, therefore, prays that liberty may be granted
to the petitioner to avail of the remedy, in accordance with law,
against the inaction on the part of the respondents including filing

appropriate proceedings for claiming the compensation for the loss suffered by the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty, as prayed for.
