MAHESH GROVER.J.

The petitioner had prayed for grant of annual grade increments and ACP Scheme. This court without going into the merits of the case had directed consideration and a final decision on the claim raised by the petitioner within a period of two months. The order of the writ court was passed on 10.10.2014.

The respondents have now filed a status report indicating that the matter has been looked into and decision can only be taken after the Registrar Cooperative Societies decides the question of relaxation in experience. An order to this effect has already been passed but the final decision would be taken within a period of one month. Let the needful be done. The petition is disposed of.

In case the final decision is not taken within a period of one month, the petitioner would be at liberty to apprise this Court by way of an application to revive the contempt petition and in which eventuality the competent authority bestowed with the power of taking decision would be burdened with exemplary costs which shall be recovered from his personal pay.
