Cost, as imposed by this Court stands deposited on
20.04.2015. The status report is, thus, taken on record.

Counsel for the parties agree that the most of the
benefits, which the petitioners are entitled to, have been granted to
them.

Sh. Balbir Singh, Director Public Instructions (Secondary
Education) Punjab, who is present in Court, states that the amount
due of arrears has already been sent to the treasury and the
payment will be released to the petitioners within a period of six
weeks. He further states that the claim of the petitioners with regard
to promotion and the consequential benefits will be considered and

decided within a period of six weeks from today. He states that in case, the claim of the petitioners for promotion is accepted, the consequential benefits will be released to them within a period of four weeks thereafter.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the petitioners to revive the same in case the time schedule, as projected by the Director Public Instructions (Secondary Education) Punjab, is not adhered to.
