It is not in dispute that the orders passed by this Court have been complied with, although counsel for the petitioner states that it is not in total compliance of the orders, as have been passed by the Writ Court. He, however, prays for liberty to initiate proceedings on the basis of the response, which has been filed by the respondent, as he submits that the action of the respondent is not sustainable in law.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty, as prayed for.
