Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has received an amount of ₹ 1,36,244/- as interest on gratuity, which is short by ₹ 16,000/- as per the calculations of the petitioner.

Liberty is granted to the petitioner to file a representation along with the certified copy of this order to the Director, Food and Civil Supplies and Consumer Affairs Department, Punjab, within a period of three weeks. If such a representation is made along with the copy of the order and the calculations, the same shall be considered and decided by the said authority within a period of six weeks from the date of submission of such representation.

In case the claim of the petitioner is accepted, the amount due be released to him within a period of three weeks thereafter. If the claim is not to be accepted, a speaking order be passed and conveyed to the petitioner forthwith.

Petition stands disposed of accordingly.
