Reply by way of affidavit of the Director, Public Instructions (Colleges) Punjab, filed in Court, taken on record, copy supplied to the counsel for the petitioner. Counsel for respondents No.1 and 2 states that the Accountant General, Punjab, has cleared the claim of the petitioner vide order dated 16.07.2015 (Annexure R-1) and a direction has been issued to the District Treasury Officer, Patiala, to release the dues to the petitioner. Direction has further been issued that family pension of the petitioner with effect from 01.01.2006 be updated.

In the light of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of with directions to the District Treasury Officer, Patiala, to release the amount due to the petitioner within a period of three
