In this case, the decree of possession was passed *inter alia* against Pritam Singh, predecessor-in-interest of the present petitioner. In the execution, the possession has been delivered on 18.05.2006 vide Rapat Roznamcha (Annexure P-5). Now, this contempt petition has been filed by Dilawar Singh, successor-in-interest of Pritam Singh.

I am of the view that the present contempt petition is nothing but a pressure tactic to pressurize the decree holder not to execute the decree.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
