AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (Oral):

Counsel for the respondents, on the basis of compliance report dated 15.01.2015, has submitted that the delay on the part of the respondents in complying with the order has been explained. He, however, states that the respondents tendered an unconditional and unqualified apology for the said delay. He further states that the orders passed by this Court have been duly complied with as the representation of the petitioner has been considered and decided by the Deputy Commissioner, Hisar, vide order dated 06.01.2015 (Annexure R-1).

In view of the above, the explanation of the respondents in delaying the matter for taking decision on the representation of the petitioner is accepted. The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order dated 06.01.2015 (Annexure R-1) passed by the Deputy Commissioner, Hisar, in accordance with law.
