AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Counsel for the State, on instructions from Sh. Vishal Shingari, Senior Assistant, O/o DPI (SE) Punjab, Chandigarh, submits that the decision has been taken to make the payment to the petitioners in compliance with the order passed by this Court, contempt of which has been alleged. He further states that the payment due to the petitioners, as per the order passed by this Court, shall be released to them within a period of 75 days from today.

In the light of the statement made by the counsel for the State and accepting the same, the present contempt petition is disposed of with directions to the respondents, as per the statement made by the counsel for

the State on instructions, to release the amount due to the petitioners within the time stated above. Liberty is also granted to the petitioners to revive the contempt petition, if the statement made by the counsel for the State, on instructions, is not adhered to.

It is made clear that if the payment is not released within the time stipulated and an application is moved for revival of the contempt petition, the Director Public Instructions (Secondary Education) shall personally be liable for the interest, which will be @ 8% P.A. from the date of order of the writ petition till the date of disbursement.
