This order shall dispose of nine contempt petitions bearing COCP Nos.**3346 of 2013** (O&M) titled as Sanjay Kumar and others Vs. Smt.Surina Rajan and others; **2611 of 2013** titled as Swadesh Kumar Vs. Smt.Surina Rajan and others; **211 of 2014** titled as Hem Chand and others Vs. Smt.Surina Rajan and others; **212 of 2013** titled as Manbir Singh and others Vs. Smt.Surina Rajan and another; **213 of 2014** titled as Rajesh Dhanda and others Vs. Smt.Surina Rajan and another; **214 of 2014** titled as Chaman Prakash and others Vs. Smt.Surina Rajan and another; **215 of 2014** titled as Gian Singh and others Vs. Smt.Surina Rajan and another; **399 of 2014** titled as Urmil Goyal Vs. Smt.Surina Rajan and another and **1571 of 2013** (O&M) titled as Shashi Sharma and others Vs. Smt.Surina Rajan and others.

Admittedly, a bunch of writ petitions was disposed of by this Court on 16.1.2013 in view of the order passed in LPA No.171 of 2012 titled as State of Haryana and others Vs. Promila Sharma and others. In all these nine cases, review applications were filed by the State which were allowed on 10.3.2015. The order dated 16.1.2013 was recalled and the writ petitions have been restored to its original numbers. Those writ petitions are still pending.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the order dated 10.3.2015 is under challenge before the Apex Court. It is also admitted that the proceedings in the writ petitions have been stayed. Consequently, learned counsel for the respondents has submitted that there is no order in the eyes of law existing which is alleged to have been disobeyed by the respondents, therefore, at this stage, these contempt petitions have become infructuous.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has rather prayed that these contempt petitions may be adjourned sine die to await the decision of the Apex Court in the review applications.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties and examining the record, I am of the considered opinion that at present there is no cause of action available with the present petitioner (s) to pursue these contempt petitions against the respondents as the order dated 16.1.2013 has already been recalled by order dated 10.3.2015 which has not been set aside by any other Court.

Consequently, at this stage, these petitions are dismissed as infructuous.
