The petitioners' writ petition was disposed of by this Court in terms of the order passed in *CWP No.16214 of 2013* titled as "*Chandi Ram and another Vs. State of Haryana and others*" decided on 29.7.2013. Thereafter, the Secretary-cum-Director General, Urban Estates, Haryana passed an order dated 24.4.2014 directing the office of DG, TCP to explore the possibility of the realignment of sector road in consultation with HUDA immediately and further ordered that final decision with regard to release of land would be taken and communicated after the issue of realignment of road would be decided. The petitioners has filed the present petition on the ground that the respondents have violated the order passed by this Court as they themselves have tried to explore the possibility

of releasing the house of the petitioners from acquisition but still his house has not been released.

After notice, the respondents have filed the reply along with report of DG, TCP (Annexure R-1) on the basis of which the Secretary-cum-Director General, Town and Country Planning Department, Haryana has passed the speaking order 16.6.2015 rejecting the claim of the petitioners for releasing of his land.

After hearing both the learned counsel for the parties, I am of the considered opinion that the order passed by this Court has been duly complied with though the order passed by the competent authority is against the petitioner, thus, learned counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the petition with liberty to challenge the order dated 16.6.2015.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

Liberty granted.
