The order dated 02.02.2015 states that the services of the petitioners would not be replaced by any other contractual employee. The period of contract having expired, the respondents have not filled up the posts by replacing the services of the petitioners by any other contractual employees. Therefore, the order passed by writ Court is not violated.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have envisaged that they would be permitted to continue till the posts for regular service were advertised in this regard. However, since the matter is pending before the Writ Court, the petitioners would be at liberty to take all the pleas before the said Court.

In view of the fact that the orders of the writ Court have been complied with, rendering the instant petition infructuous, the same is disposed of as such .
