C.M. is allowed. Reply by way of short affidavit on behalf of
respondent No. 2 is taken on record.

COCP No. 3327 of 2014

Counsel for the respondents has produced a copy of the
calculation to the pay fixation of the petitioner, copy of which has
been handed over to the counsel for the petitioner. Counsel for the
respondents states that the difference of pay has been paid to the
petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner states that as per the stand of the respondents and the documents attached therewith, dated 26.09.2012 (Annexure R-1) para 3 thereof, the benefit has been generalized w.e.f. 01.01.1997 but the petitioner has not been granted the said benefit from the said date. He states that the petitioner would also be entitled to the benefit of arrears from the date of the order dated 27.09.2012 whereas the arrears, in the case of the petitioner, have been granted from 01.05.2014 onwards.

The petitioner may avail of his remedy, in accordance with law, as per the above including the representation to the respondents, which, if submitted within a period of four weeks from today, shall be considered and decided by the respondents within a period of eight weeks from the date of submission of the representation along with the copy of this order.

The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
