The order dated 11.10.2013, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to convene a meeting of the Committee within 15 days and to complete the review exercise within two months thereafter. It was further mandated that in clear cut cases decided in favour of the aggrieved petitioners there would no necessity of passing any order, however, in disputed matters speaking orders shall be passed.

Reply indicates that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed.

In view of above, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioners to challenge the order so passed in case he is dis-satisfied with the same.
