Counsel for the petitioners does not dispute the fact that the allotment order dated 02.03.2015 (Annexure R-3/1) has been passed by the respondents but the possession of the land and the proprietary rights have not been conferred upon the petitioners till date.

Counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Sh. Rajbir Singh, Tehsildar (Sales) Gurgaon-respondent No. 3, who is present in Court, states that the possession and the proprietary rights will be conferred upon the petitioners within a period of four weeks' from today.

In view of the statement made by the counsel for respondent No. 3, the present contempt petition is disposed of as

infructuous with liberty to the petitioners to revive the same, in case the time, within which the possession and the proprietary rights have to be conferred upon the petitioners, is not adhered to.
