In the instant Civil Original Contempt Petition violation of order dated 07.08.2013 passed in Civil Writ Petition has been complained of. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that vide order dated 07.08.2013 directions were issued to the respondents to remove the unauthorized construction made by persons mentioned in para no.3 of the writ petition, by executing the ejectment order that has become final as per record placed before the Court and if no such order is found in existence then to take action under the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 by referring the matter to the Assistant Collector Ist Grade. The needful was required to be done within six weeks. Petitioner was to be given opportunity of hearing before passing the order.

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Reply by way of affidavit of Chander Shekhar, the then D.C., Sonipat has been filed, in which it has been stated that a case under Section 7 of the Act 1961 has been filed against the persons mentioned in paragraph 3 of the Writ Petition, which is pending in the Court of Assistant Collector, Ist Grade Ganaur, District Sonipat for 03.06.2014. It has been further stated that in respect of one Shiv Avtar, the ejection proceedings have been finalised and the necessary consequential action for ejectment has been initiated.

The order of this Court having thus been complied with, this petition is disposed of as infructuous.

Rule is discharged.
