On 19.6.2014, while disposing of the writ petition, filed by the petitioner, respondent No.2 was directed to look into the issue and take a decision in accordance with law on the application filed by the petitioner within three weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

In the reply filed today, on behalf of the respondents, the respondents have admitted to have received certified copy of the order on 4.7.2014. If three weeks are to be counted, it would end up in the month of July, 2014 whereas, the NOC has been issued to the petitioner in the month of April, 2015, which is clearly beyond the period fixed by this Court.

Though, the compliance has been made but it has caused unnecessary inconvenience to the petitioner, therefore, the present petition is hereby disposed of and the respondents are saddled with cost of ₹30,000/- to be paid to the petitioner by way of demand draft.
