Learned counsel for the respondent/Bank has submitted that the decision passed by this Court in LPA No.1869 of 2014 has been stayed by the Supreme Court in SLP(C) No.235 of 2015. In para No.6 of the affidavit filed by the Chief Manager of the Bank, it is categorically averred that if the SLP filed by the Bank before the Supreme Court is dismissed, the respondent/Bank would pay the pensionary benefits to the petitioner as directed in the order dated 29.8.2014 passed in CWP No.21280 of 2008.

In view of the clear stand taken by the Bank, by way of an undertaking, that the amount of the petitioner would be paid as soon as the SLP filed by the Bank is dismissed by the Supreme Court, this petition does not survive and is hereby dismissed.
