Cost, as imposed by this Court, stands deposited. The status report is taken on record.

Counsel for the respondents, on the basis of the status report which is in the form of an affidavit while referring to para-5, states that the amount due to the petitioner has been released except for Bill No. 7 dated 16.05.2015, which has been submitted online to the treasury for payment, which fact he could not verify as to whether the said amount has actually been released to the petitioner or not.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with directions to the District Treasury Officer, Chandigarh to release the amount of ₹ 35,02,443/- as per Bill No. 7 dated 16.05.2015 to the petitioner, if already not released, within a period of four

weeks from today.

It would be open to the petitioner to file a representation, in case the claim, as has been made to the respondents, has not been released to it. The representation, if submitted, shall be considered and decided by respondent No. 2 within a period of six weeks of submission of such representation. In case, the representation is accepted, the consequential benefits, if any, be released to the petitioner within a further period of four weeks.
