MAHESH GROVER, J.

The order dated 12.9.2014, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioners mandated the respondents to consider and decide the representations made by the petitioners and in case they are found entitled for the benefit, the same shall be provided to them within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order. It was further directed that in case of denial a speaking order be passed.

It has been stated by the learned counsel for the respondent that needful has since been done and a speaking order passed.

In view of above, instant petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such, with liberty to the petitioner to challenge the order so passed in case of they being dis-satisfied with the same.
