An additional affidavit of the Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Mohali, District SAS Nagar, has been filed in Court, according to which, the payment of ₹ 3,00,000/- was made to the petitioner on 27.08.2014 but interest initially was not paid. Now interest @ 9% has been paid on the amount of ₹ 3,00,000/-.

Counsel for the respondents, on instructions from Sh. Gurmukh Singh, Steno, O/o Sub-Divisional Magistrate, Mohali, District SAS Nagar, states that the remaining amount of 36,000/- along with 9% interest, as per the order passed by this Court, shall be released to the petitioner within a period of four weeks' from today.

In the light of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty to the petitioner to revive the same, if the time schedule is not adhered to by the respondents.
