The order dated 15.9.2014, non-compliance of which is alleged by the petitioner mandated the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice and take a decision in accordance with law/policy within a period of three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order.

It has been stated by the learned counsel for the State that needful has since been done. Learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record a copy of the order dated 30.3.2015 passed in compliance of the orders of the writ Court and has stated that the petitioner has been held eligible for 100 sq.yards plot.
